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Meet the cast — and what each one teaches

Character	What they carry
Mayor Subject	Subject (noun/pronoun performing the action)
Verb Verity	Verb (action / state of being)
Object Otto	Direct / indirect object (receiver of the verb's action)
Modifier Mike	Adverb (modifies verb / adjective / other adverb)
Modifier Madge	Adjective (modifies noun / pronoun)
Connector Chen	Conjunction (coordinating / subordinating — <i>and, but, because, although</i>)
Pronoun Perry	Pronoun (substitute for noun — <i>he, she, they, it, who</i>)
Article Anne	Article (<i>a, an, the</i> — definite vs. indefinite)
Preposition Pat	Preposition (spatial / temporal relations — <i>on, under, between, before</i>)
Clause-Chief Carla	Clause-types (independent / dependent / subordinate / relative)
Punctuator Polly	Punctuation guardian (commas, semicolons, apostrophes, colons, dashes)
Agreement Ada	Subject-verb agreement (singular subject → singular verb; plural subject → plural verb; tricky cases — collective nouns, <i>either/or</i> , indefinite pronouns)
