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Meet the cast — and what each one teaches

Character	What they carry
Claim	Claim-identification — what EXACTLY is being asserted? distinguish claim from opinion from feeling from prediction
Weigh	Credibility-evaluation — who's in a position to KNOW? what stake? calibration not verdict (shared design language with DebateForge Weigh)
Trace	Evidence-traceback — where does this claim ORIGINATE? what's the chain? open four tabs; follow it back
Update	Belief-revision — being WRONG is how knowledge MOVES; visibly carry old-guess and new-guess as data (shared design language with DebateForge Yield)
Wonder	Epistemic-humility — 'I don't know yet' is the START of knowing; trust calibrated to evidence; counter-cynicism
